NSIPS CORRESPONDENTS MISSING IN CARACAS FOUR DAYS AFTER ASSASSINATION ATTEMPT

NOV. 16 (IPS) -- THREE CORRESPONDENTS OF THE CARACAS, VENEZUELA BUREAU OF NEW SOLIDARITY INTERNATIONAL PRESS SERVICE (NSIPS) HAVE BEEN MISSING SINCE 8 A.M. THIS MORNING. LORENZO AND SYLVIA CARRASCO AND JESUS MARQUEZ HAVE NOT BEEN SEEN SINCE THEY LEFT THEIR HOMES THIS MORNING. THE THREE FAILED TO KEEP A 6 P.M. APPOINTMENT.

THE DISAPPEARANCE OF THE THREE COMES IN THE MIDDLE OF AN INTERNATIONAL WAVE OF PHYSICAL ATTACKS AGAINST WRITERS FOR NSIPS AND MEMBERS OF THE INTERNATIONAL CAUCUS OF LABOR COMMITTEES AS ROCKEFELLER CONTROLLED POLICE AGENCIES DESPERATELY CARRY OUT ORDERS TO HALT LABOR COMMITTEE ORGANIZING FOR ITS INTERNATIONAL DEVELOPMENT BANK PROPOSAL.

FOUR DAYS AGO IN CARACAS, LORENZO CARRASCO AND ANOTHER NSIPS JOURNALIST WERE THE TARGETS OF AN ATTEMPTED ASSASSINATION BY POLICE-LED MAOIST GOONS. TWENTY TO THIRTY MAOIST FASCISTS JUMPED THE TWO AND ATTEMPTED TO KILL THEM WITH CHAINS AND BOTTLES. THE ATTACK WAS LINKED TO A SERIES OF BOTH PHYSICAL ATTACKS AND LIBELOUS SLANDERS AGAINST IPS BEING COORDINATED INTERNATIONALLY BY SWEDISH PRIME MINISTER AND CIA OPERATIVE OLOF PALME.

ASSOCIATES OF THE THREE IN CARACAS HAVE NOTIFIED POLICE OFFICIALS OF THE DISAPPEARANCE.
