## **I. INTERNATIONAL PRESS WRAP-UP: INTERNATIONAL NEWS.**

### **PCOE HOLDS PUBLIC MEETING IN FRANCE.**

PARIS, NOV. 18 (IPS)—THE PRO-SOVIET SPANISH COMMUNIST WORKERS PARTY (PCOE), LED BY FORMER SPANISH REPUBLICAN GENERAL ENRIQUE LISTER, HELD AN OPEN PUBLIC MEETING ATTENDED BY 500 PERSONS YESTERDAY IN PARIS, FRANCE.

THE FEATURED SPEAKER, GEN. LISTER, CHARACTERIZED THE CIA-CONTROLLED SPANISH COMMUNIST PARTY OF AGENT SANTIAGO CARRILLO AS A "NEW PARTY WHICH HAS GIVEN UP THE NOTION OF CLASS STRUGGLE IN ORDER TO INTEGRATE ITSELF INTO STATE MONOPOLY CAPITALISM THROUGH CONCILIATING IT." LISTER DENOUNCED CARRILLO FOR HIS ATTACKS ON THE PORTUGUESE REVOLUTION AND ITS LEADERSHIP, THE PORTUGUESE COMMUNIST PARTY (PCP).

OBSERVERS CONCLUDED THAT THE MEETING HAD RECEIVED HEAVY BEHIND-THE-SCENES SUPPORT FROM THE FRENCH COMMUNIST PARTY, BECAUSE POLITICAL MEETINGS BY IMMIGRANTS AND EXILES ARE NORMALLY PROHIBITED BY THE FRENCH GOVERNMENT.

### **JAPAN ESTABLISHES FUSION COUNCIL.**

NOV. 18 (IPS)—THE JAPANESE ATOMIC ENERGY COMMISSION (JAEC) HAS ANNOUNCED ITS INTENTION TO ESTABLISH A "FUSION COUNCIL" TO PROMOTE A COORDINATED DEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR CONTROLLED THERMONUCLEAR FUSION RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT, TO PROMOTE INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION IN FUSION, AND TO PROMOTE TRAINING OF FUSION SCIENTISTS. THE ANNOUNCEMENT WAS MADE NOV. 11 BY CHAIRMAN SASAKI OF THE JAEC, ALSO HEAD OF THE JAPANESE SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY AGENCY, AND REPORTED IN THE NOV. 11 ISSUE OF JAPAN ECONOMIC JOURNAL.

THE COUNCIL WILL APPARENTLY BECOME OPERATIONAL IMMEDIATELY; TWO LEADING SCIENTISTS AND OFFICIALS HAVE ALREADY BEEN NAMED TO IT. THE ANNOUNCEMENT IS THE FIRST MOVE TO IMPLEMENT JAPANESE PRIME MINISTER MIKI'S PROPOSAL FOR AN INTERNATIONAL COMMITMENT TO FUSION DEVELOPMENT MADE AT THE RAMBOUILLET ECONOMIC SUMMIT.

### **EURO CP'S FINAL PREPARATORY MEETING FOR BERLIN CONFERENCE STARTS.**

NOV. 18 (IPS)—THE ITALIAN PAPER PAESE SERA, LINKED TO THE ITALIAN COMMUNIST PARTY (PCI), REPORTED YESTERDAY THAT PCI LEADERS SERGIO

SEGRE AND GIANCARLO PAJETTA HAVE DEPARTED TO BERLIN FOR THE SCHEDULED FINAL CONSULTATIVE MEETING IN PREPARATION FOR THE CONFERENCE OF EUROPEAN COMMUNIST AND WORKERS' PARTIES. THIS MEETING IS SLATED TO FINALIZE THE DRAFT DOCUMENT AND SET A DATE FOR THE CONFERENCE.

SEGRE WANTS "PROGRAMMING" A LA WILLY BRANDT.

NOV. 18 (IPS)—SERGIO SEGRE, THE CIA AGENT FOREIGN POLICY SPOKESMAN OF THE COMMUNIST PARTY OF ITALY (PCI), GAVE AN INTERVIEW TO THE WEST GERMAN WEEKLY NEWSPAPER DIE ZEIT SHORTLY BEFORE HIS RECENT TRIP TO THE UNITED STATES. IN THE INTERVIEW, PUBLISHED THIS WEEKEND, SEGRE EMPHASIZED THE PRIORITY OF "THE QUALITY OF LIFE" OVER PRIVATE CONSUMPTION. HE QUOTED WEST GERMAN SOCIAL DEMOCRATIC PARTY CHAIRMAN WILLY BRANDT IN CALLING FOR ECONOMIC "PROGRAMMING"—WHERE EVERYONE FINDS HIS PLACE—RATHER THAN "PLANNING".

"THE CAPITALIST WORLD HAS EXPERIENCED ITS OWN DEVELOPMENT IN THE PAST 59 YEARS," SAID SEGRE, INSISTING THAT WE DO NOT BELIEVE THE ITALIAN SITUATION IS THAT OF THE RUSSIAN SITUATION OF 1905 OR 1917, OR WILL BE." HE ADDED, "IN NO WAY DO WE WANT TO REPEAT THE EXPERIENCES OF EASTERN EUROPE, NOT ONLY IN THE STALIN PERIOD, BUT ALSO AFTERWARD."

"IN NO WAY ARE WE STRIVING FOR THE SOLE RULE OF THE COMMUNIST PARTY OR THE WORKING CLASS," SEGRE TOLD DIE ZEIT. "IF ITALY'S DEMOCRACY...ACTUALLY DEVELOPED IN THE LAST 30 YEARS DESPITE ALL THE CRISES, IT IS ABOVE ALL BECAUSE IT NEVER CAME TO A FRONTAL SPLIT IN THE COUNTRY." SEGRE SAID HIS PARTY'S WORST FEAR IS OF HAVING TO GOVERN WITHOUT FIRST ACHIEVING A COMPROMISE WITH THE CONSERVATIVE CHRISTIAN DEMOCRATS.

II. CONTINENTAL NEWS.

MEXICAN COLUMNIST DOCUMENTS CIA, POLICE INVOLVEMENT IN DRUG-RUNNING IN MEXICO.

NOV. 18 (IPS)—SALVADOR LOZANO, COLUMNIST FOR THE MEXICO CITY DAILY EL SOL, ATTACKED "HIGH AUTHORITIES" IN MEXICO WHO PROTECT DRUG TRAFFIC IN A COLUMN ON NOV. 14.

TAKING ISSUE WITH A STATEMENT MADE RECENTLY BY THE MINISTER OF DEFENSE, GEN. CUENCA DIAZ, THAT "VENAL JUDGES" AND "DEFICIENCIES IN THE PENAL LAW" PREVENT ADEQUATE CONTROL OF ILLEGAL DRUG TRAFFIC, LOZANO NOTES THE BUSINESS GOES FAR BEYOND VENAL JUDGES." HE CHARGED POLICE AGENCIES WITH DIRECT COMPLICITY, CITING A RECENT SHOOT-OUT IN MEXICO CITY IN WHICH FEDERAL SECURITY POLICE, ON THE TRAIL OF SOME NORTH AMERICAN NARCOTICS DEALERS, DISCOVERED SEVERAL POUNDS OF COCAINE IN THE POSSESSION OF AGENTS OF THE FEDERAL JUDICIAL POLICE WHO WERE TO MAKE CONTACT WITH THE NORTH AMERICAN DEALERS.

AFTER NOTING THAT "THE CIA ITSELF HAS OVERSEEN POPPY-GROWING IN ASIA," LOZANO ATTACKED CUENCA DIAZ FOR HIS SUGGESTION THAT PEASANTS FOUND GROWING NARCOTICS SHOULD BE DEPRIVED OF THEIR LAND.

BOSTON, BUFFALO MEDIA BREAK LAROUCHE-HIT BLACKOUT.

NOV. 18 (IPS)—ABC-TV IN BOSTON AND THE BUFFALO COURIER EXPRESS HAVE BROKEN STORIES OVER THE LAST 48 HOURS ON THE THREAT TO THE LIFE OF LABOR PARTY PRESIDENTIAL CANDIDATE LYNDON LAROUCHE, JR. THESE REPORTS ARE THE ONLY MAJOR CRACKS IN THE OTHERWISE CONTINUING NATIONAL PRESS BLACKOUT.

ABC-TV-BOSTON REPORTED IN ITS 11:00 PM NEWS REPORT SUNDAY NIGHT THAT THE USLP HAD CHARGED THAT BOTH PRESIDENTIAL CANDIDATES GERALD FORD AND LAROUCHE HAD RECENTLY RECEIVED THREATS TO THEIR LIVES. THE REPORT THEN STATED THAT DICK GREGORY, WHO HAD JOINED THE USLP AT A PRESS CONFERENCE EARLIER THAT SAME NIGHT, SAID: "I'M WORRIED ABOUT THE LABOR PARTY...IF THE GOVERNMENT IS NOT TO MAKE AN INVESTIGATION, THEN I THINK IT IS VERY IMPORTANT FOR THEM TO SAY TO THE LABOR PARTY, TO THE AMERICAN PEOPLE, AND TO THE WORLD WHY NOT."

THE BUFFALO COURIER EXPRESS, A CONSERVATIVE ANTI-ROCKEFELLER PAPER, RAN A SHORT BACK-PAGE REPORT ENTITLED: "LABOR PARTY HOPEFUL CITES DEATH THREAT." THE LEAD THEN STATED THAT THE USLP IS CHARGING "AN OFFICIAL CONSPIRACY TO ASSASSINATE LYNDON LAROUCHE, THE PARTY'S PRESIDENTIAL CANDIDATE FOR 1976."

UNION BUYS COMPANY WITH WORKERS' SAVINGS.

NOV. 18 (IPS)—THE BROTHERHOOD OF AIRLINE AND RAILWAY CLERKS (BRAC) UNION EXECUTIVE ANNOUNCED NOV. 13 THAT THEY HAVE FORMED A NEW ORGANIZATION — THE BRAC EMPLOYEES EXPRESS — TO PURCHASE ROUTES OF THE REA EXPRESS COMPANY WHICH WAS DECLARED BANKRUPT IN FEDERAL COURT THE SAME DAY. BRAC'S NEW ORGANIZATION WILL FINANCE ACQUISITION OF THE REA EXPRESS COMPANY BY SELLING STOCK IN THE NEW ORGANIZATION TO THE 7,000 WORKERS ON THE OLD BANKRUPT COMPANY'S PAYROLL. IN OTHER WORDS, BRAC WORKERS WILL BUY THEIR OWN COMPANY AND PAY THEIR OWN WAGES THROUGH DEPLETING ALL THEIR AVAILABLE SAVINGS.

AT THE SAME TIME, LAST WEEK BRAC'S UNION EXECUTIVE — FRONTING FOR CHAIRMAN MAO — PROPOSED THAT IT TITHE ALL ITS MEMBERS FIVE DOLLARS APIECE TO THEN CONTRIBUTE THE CUMULATIVE AMOUNT OF \$30,000 TO FINANCIALLY DISTRESSED NEW YORK CITY.

BIRCH BAYH OFFERS FOOD TO THE THIRD WORLD IN EXCHANGE FOR ZERO GROWTH.

PORTLAND, NOV. 18 (IPS)—BIRCH BAYH, DEMOCRATIC PRESIDENTIAL HOPEFUL, CALLED FOR A NEW FOREIGN POLICY DIRECTED TOWARD A "PLANETARY BARGAIN", IN WHICH THE U.S. WOULD "BRIBE COUNTRIES" TO REDUCE POPULATION GROWTH BY SUPPLYING THEM WITH FOOD AND TECHNOLOGY.

SPEAKING AT THE WAYNE MORSE MEMORIAL BANQUET HERE ON SUNDAY, BAYH CALLED FOR USING 2AMERICAN AGRICULTURAL CAPACITY TO RESTRUCTURE THE WORLD FOOD SUPPLY, INCLUDING THE PROPORTIONING OF WORLD AGRICULTURAL RESOURCES." HE ALSO CALLED FOR REDUCING THE ARMS RACE AND EXPRESSED FEAR OF THE POOR COUNTRIES GETTING WEAPONS.

III. ORGANIZING AND INTELLIGENCE REPORT.

CAREY LEGISLATION OPENS UP DISCUSSION ON WHAT KIND OF MORATORIUM.

NOV. 18 (IPS)--THE DEBT MORATORIUM LEGISLATION PASSED BY THE NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATURE AND SIGNED INTO LAW BY GOVERNOR CAREY LATE FRIDAY NIGHT HAS OPENED UP FOR DEBATE THE QUESTION OF WHAT KIND OF MORATORIUM WILL ACTUALLY BE IMPLEMENTED.

THE ENACTED BILL DIRECTS THE PRIVATE INVESTORS WHO HOLD \$1.6 BILLION IN SHORT-TERM NOTES WHICH COME DUE THE REST OF THIS FISCAL YEAR TO EITHER ACCEPT A THREE-YEAR MORATORIUM ON REPAYMENT AND RECEIVED REDUCED INTEREST PAYMENTS, OR EXCHANGE THEIR SHORT-TERM NOTES FOR 15-YEAR BONDS. COUPLED WITH A MASSIVE AUSTERITY PROGRAM AND FEDERAL LOAN GUARANTEES, MOST BANK ANALYSTS REGARD THE MORATORIUM AS A BOON TO THE BANKS. THE BANKS HAVE VOLUNTARILY AGREED TO A MORATORIUM ON THEIR NOTES, ACCORDING TO THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE IN ALBANY.

HOWEVER, NEW YORK FINANCIAL ANALYSTS ARE ALREADY QUESTIONING THE LEGALITY OF THE MORATORIUM AS PROPOSED. ACCORDING TO THE CHIEF MUNICIPAL BOND TRADER AT A FIRM THAT SPECIALIZES IN NEW YORK SECURITIES, IT WOULD BE ILLEGAL TO DISCRIMINATE AGAINST ONE CLASS OF SECURITIES HOLDER. "THE CITY HAS PUT ITS FULL FAITH AND CREDIT BEHIND ITS NOTES AS WELL AS ITS BONDS...IF THEY WANT TO STAND A CHANCE LEGALLY, THEY'LL HAVE TO GO FOR A MORATORIUM ON BONDS AND NOTES. OTHERWISE THE NOTEHOLDERS WILL PUT UP A FUSS."

ASKED WHETHER THE LEGISLATION WOULD HOLD EVEN IF THE OTHER PARTS OF THE CAREY PACKAGE -- THE TAX HIKE AND BUDGET CUTS -- DID NOT PASS THE LEGISLATURE, A PARTNER IN THE LEGAL FIRM OF MAC COUNSEL SIMON RIFKIND POINTED OUT THAT THE BILL HAS ALREADY BEEN SIGNED INTO LAW BY THE GOVERNOR.

"OF COURSE, THE FAILURE OF THE LEGISLATURE TO PASS THE REST OF THE PACKAGE WOULD BE AN IMPEDIMENT TO FEDERAL AID," THE SOURCE STATED. "FURTHERMORE, IF THE TAXES AND CUTS ARE NOT APPROVED, THE MORATORIUM MIGHT HAVE TO BE BROADENED TO INCLUDE BONDS; AND, THREE YEARS DOWN THE ROAD, INVESTORS MIGHT FIND THAT THE MORATORIUM HAD BEEN EXTENDED."

IS AMIN A SOUTH AFRICAN AGENT?

NOV. 18 (IPS)--IN RESPONSE TO THE CALL OF THE ORGANIZATION OF AFRICAN UNITY (OAU) CHAIRMAN AND UGANDAN PRESIDENT IDI AMIN FOR THE THREE ANGOLAN LIBERATION GROUPS TO FORM A COALITION GOV-

ERNMENT AND FOR HIMSELF TO BE PLACED PERSONALLY IN CHARGE OF AN OAU "PEACEKEEPING FORCE" TO INTERVENE IN ANGOLA, SOMALIA, ALGERIA, AND TANZANIA CALLED FOR A HEADS OF STATE SPECIAL SUMMIT MEETING OF THE OAU TO DISCUSS THE ANGOLAN SITUATION.

HEADING THE ANTI-AMIN FACTION, SEKO TOURE OF GUINEA LAST WEEK ISSUED A DECLARATION, REPORTED IN WEST GERMANY'S DIE WELT, DEMANDING ALL COUNTRIES SUPPORT THE MPLA BOTH DIPLOMATICALLY AND MATERIALLY IN ORDER TO LIQUIDATE ALL FOREIGN TROOPS IN ANGOLA (A REFERENCE TO SOUTH AFRICAN TROOPS AND PORTUGUESE MERCENARIES FIGHTING ON THE SIDE OF FNLA AND UNITA).

TODAY FRANKFURTER RUNDSCHAU REPORTED THAT TOURE HAD SAID THAT ALL PRESENTLY "NEUTRAL" AFRICAN STATES SHOULD SUPPORT THE MPLA GOVERNMENT.

\*THE ANTI-MPLA AFRICAN FACTION IS FREAKING OUT IN RESPONSE TO WELL-PUBLISHED SOVIET AID TO THE MPLA. SUNDAY'S BRITISH DAILY TELEGRAPH REPORTS OF ZAIRE'S FAT MOBUTU'S ANTI-SOVIET RAVINGS, SAYING HE WOULD SEND HIS MIRAGE FIGHTERS INTO ANGOLA IF THE RUSSIANS INTERVENED WITH MIGS. MOBUTU ALSO WENT TO GABON TO SOLICIT SUPPORT FOR FNLA/UNITA FROM PRESIDENT BONGO WHO HAD ALREADY OFFICIALLY ENDORSED THE NEW MPLA GOVERNMENT. TO APPEASE AMIN, TOGETHER THEY ISSUED A CALL FOR ANOTHER SPECIAL OAU MEETING, ATTEMPTING TO GIVE CREDENCE TO AMIN'S ANTI-COMMUNIST LINE.

AMIN'S POSITION ON ANGOLA IS IDENTICAL TO SOUTH AFRICA'S POINT WHICH COULD LAND HIM IN HOT WATER WITH OTHER AFRICAN COUNTRIES. IT APPEARS AS THOUGH FASCIST APARTHEID SOUTH AFRICA IS SUPPORTED BY BLACK AFRICAN AMIN.
